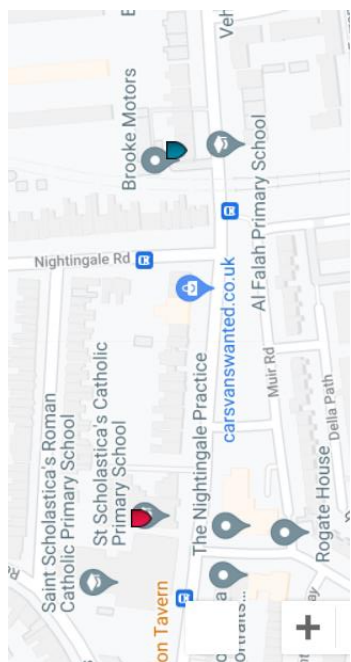

- Monthly Movie nights (first Friday of the month) afterschool (03:30-05:00) to raise money for St Josephs

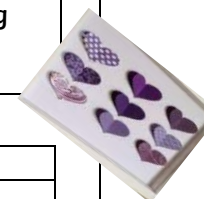

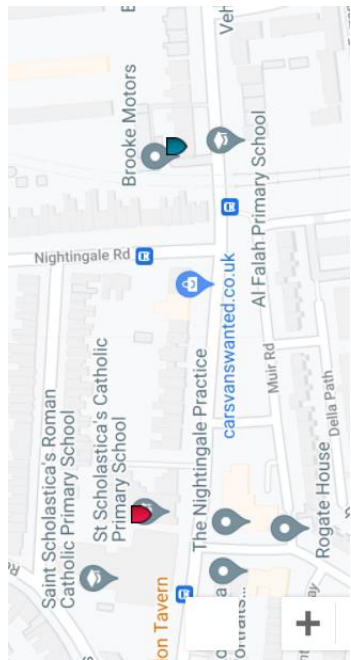
